The ride doesn't have the same view as the cable cars, it takes 45 minutes from Heidelberg Bizmarkplatz. There are streetcars that will take you from Heidelberg Main Train Station to Bizmarkplatz.

Walking up to the Königstuhl		Visitors can also climb the mountain on foot, with the help of the Himmelsleiter. With over 1200 steps, the Himmelsleiter is a gigantic staircase that leads from Heidelberg Castle directly to the summit region of the Königstuhl. The irregular staircase, which consists of rough and uneven stones, begins directly at the Molkenkur-Weg. If the steps from the Kornmarkt in the Old Town are counted as well, the staircase comes to about 1600 steps.
