Overview

The Barbarossa District 2025 Cub Scout, **Harvest Hullabaloo**, will be held on Saturday, 4 October. **Harvest Hullabaloo** will be held on the McCully Sports Field on McCully Kaserne Ober-Olmer-Straße, 55263 Ingelheim am Rhein. Check-in will begin at 08:00 and will conclude at approximately 16:00. All scouts registered in the Transatlantic Council are invited to attend. The registration fee is \$20 per scout and includes all program activities and a patch. Siblings are welcome to attend. The registration fee for siblings is \$5 and for adults is \$5. 1. General Information & Planning

1.1 Registration & Payment

Registration and payment can be completed at: <https://scoutingevent.com/802-Harvesthullabaloo> All Cub Scouts in the Transatlantic Council are welcome to attend and participate.

1.2 Adults & Older Scouts

Both adults and older scouts are needed to help run **Harvest Hullabaloo** to include checking in, checking out, program activity stations, and administrative duties. Those who are interested in assisting can email Leah Gililand at barbarossascoutseventchair@gmail.com. If you are a scout, please ensure your unit leader and/or parent is included on the email.

1.3 Installation Access

Installation access is required for McCully Barracks. All individuals needing installation access will be added to an access roster. Please indicate during registration that you need to be added to the roster. You must bring your passport as a form of ID upon arrival.

1.4 Camping

Camping will be available to Units and their families beginning Friday at 17:00, 3 October until Sunday 11:00, 5 October. It is recommended that all units have access to a cellular phone with a primary contact number for parents and **Harvest Hullabaloo** Staff. Units camping must have a BALOO certified leader in attendance. This is a trash in trash out event, all units are responsible for leaving sites clean and in good condition upon departure. 1.4 Getting to the Site & Parking

Harvest Hullabaloo will be held on the McCully Kaserne Field area. The address for the McCully Kaserne Ober-Olmer-Straße, 55263 Ingelheim am Rhein. Signs will direct you to

the location once you enter the gate. Parking will be in the parking lot; no vehicles will be allowed in the field area.



1.5 Arrival Procedures

Units should plan to arrive between 08:00 and 09:00 on Saturday, 04 October. A check-in area will be available where the unit's rotation schedule will be provided.

1.6 Trash & Recycling

Units should plan to pack out all trash and recycling as dumpsters and/or recycling bins may not be available.

2. Event Organization & Safety

2.1 Emergency Contact

It is recommended that all units have access to a mobile phone in case of emergency. This number and the POC should be made available to **Harvest Hullabaloo** staff in the event staff need to reach the unit. The event emergency POC is Leah Gililand, 01759972479.

2.2 First Aid

A First Aid station will be set up and prominently marked. Additional individuals with First Aid supplies will be available and wearing identifying apparel. If assistance is needed,

please contact one of the **Harvest Hullabaloo** staff. If an injury occurs and IF the injury permits, bring the injured individual to the First Aid station for medical attention.

2.3 Medical Forms

In case of severe injury or illness requiring emergency medical services or hospital treatment, a health history record and permission of a parent/guardian are required. The Medical Forms must be accessible to unit leaders at all times. Parts A and B are required for all youth and adults attending **Harvest Hullabaloo**. Please maintain all health forms in a binder and bring to the event in case of emergencies. All Medical Forms must be validated by camp staff during check-in.

2.4 Fire & Ambulance

In the unlikely event that fire and/or ambulance services are needed, immediately send a runner to the First Aid station so an emergency call can be placed and the event director can be notified. If the call is placed from your current location, a runner must still be sent so the event director can be notified and emergency services can be properly directed upon arrival.

3. Harvest Hullabaloo Program

3.1 Program Stations

Program stations will be a combination of scout skills, teambuilding, and fun all within the **Harvest Hullabaloo** theme. Units will rotate through all 10 stations throughout the day with 5 stations before the lunch break and 5 stations after the lunch break.

3.2 Lunch

Scouts/Units are responsible for their own lunch. There will only be 45 minutes for lunch, so bringing a sack lunch is recommended as there will not likely be time to prepare a lunch.

3.2 Unit Sizes

Ranks/Age Groups will rotate together through the program stations; however, larger groups may be broken down into smaller groups. **Harvest Hullabaloo** staff will work with units if there are any questions.

3.4 Gear List

In addition to their packed lunch, scouts should bring a mug for hot beverages. Scouts should be prepared to be outdoors for the entire day so all cold-weather essentials are a must. Units should bring a small first aid kit.

3.5 Trick or Treating

Units/Families are invited to bring Halloween candy for Cubs to Trick or Treat through the campsites the evening of Saturday, October 4th. Trick or Treating will commence after completion of Camp Fire.
