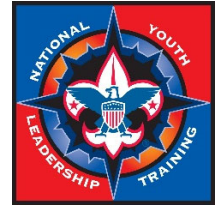

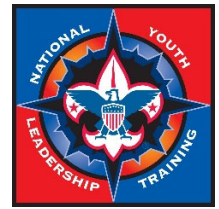

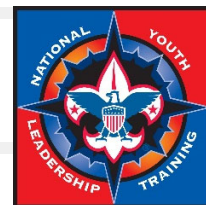

## (2) Eligibility

<b>Participant</b>	<p><b>To attend a NYLT course, a youth must have the following qualifications by the beginning of the course:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Must be a registered member of a scouting unit.</li><li>• Must have a current BSA Health and Medical Record form parts A, B, and C.</li><li>• Scouts BSA members (male and female) must be at least 13. They must have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops. They must earn the First Class rank before attending NYLT.</li><li>• Venturers and Sea Scouts (male and female) must be at least 14, or 13 and have completed eighth grade, and fall within the maximum age allowance for their program. They must have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews or Ships. It is recommended that they have had at least one year of camping experience. While NYLT is not an outdoor skills course, it is important that each participant have basic camping and outdoor cooking experience.</li><li>• Have a unit leader recommendation</li></ul>
<b>Youth Staff</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be registered with BSA</li><li>• Be at least age 14.</li><li>• Have held positions of leadership in their home unit</li><li>• Have been an NYLT course participant skills course, or received Course Director Approval to Staff with other BSA course in lieu of such as Kodiak, OA High Adventure, etc.</li></ul>
<b>Adult Staff</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be current registered with BSA</li><li>• Completed YPT</li><li>• Can attend the NYLT course and staff development</li></ul>
