■ Required Items

- Notebook or Scout Leader's Handbook – for taking notes
- Pen/Pencil
- Printed or digital copy of BALOO Participant Guide (downloadable from Scouting.org)
- Access to My.Scouting.org – for online module verification
- Computer, tablet, or smartphone with camera & microphone
- Stable internet connection
- Zoom (or designated platform) installed and updated

■ Practice Materials (for at-home participation)

- First Aid Kit (basic supplies)
- Rope or paracord (6–10 ft) – for knot-tying practice
- Pocketknife or multitool (if permitted and used safely)
- Compass
- Tent or shelter materials (if you'd like to follow along with demonstrations)
- Cooking utensils (measuring cups, spatula, pot/pan – for simple meal planning demos)
- Food needed to prepare a foil pack meal, foil and a fire source.
- Fire safety items (matches or lighter, water bucket, optional camp stove for later hands-on use)
- Sample menu plan and grocery list (for meal planning exercise)
- First Aid reference card or BSA Guide to Safe Scouting
- Outdoor activity plan template (provided during training)

- Quiet space free of distractions
- Headset or earbuds for clear audio
- Comfortable chair and good lighting
- Snacks and water nearby
