Visitor's Documents Required

Japanese Citizens

One of the following:

- Japanese Passport
- Residence Card with picture
- My Number card with picture and supplemental documents
- Medical ID Card (under 12)
- Student ID Cards
- JSDF ID Cards
- National Public Service ID (Kokka Komuinsho)
- Japanese Driver's License (*will require guests to enter their eight-digit PIN into the Japanese Immigration computer to verify country of origin.*)

If guests cannot remember their PIN, they will have to go to a Japanese Police Station and re-register their PIN, or must provide one of the below additional documents:

- Koseki Tohon: must show driver's name
- Juminhyo: must show permanent address (honseki)
- Koseki Kojinjiko Shomeisho: must match driver's license
- Koseki Zenbujiko Shomeisho: must match driver's license



US Citizens

One of the following:

- Social Security Number
- Taxpayer ID Number

AND one of the following:

- U.S. Passport with valid landing permission
- Japanese Residence Card



Other Nationalities

One of the following:

- Passport with a valid landing permission
- Residence Card with a valid Visa

Note: United States Forces Japan has identified certain countries for increased scrutiny. Contact your local pass office to determine if your guest is a **Designated Third Country National**.

These require Garrison Commander approval. Submit requests a minimum of 30 days out.

*Department of Defense Common Access Card Holders are not required to obtain a pass to enter an installation. However, they are still required to obtain permission to reside in on-post housing as a House Guest.
