

## THINGS TO DO...

### GAME VAULT:

We highly encourage and hope that you bring your favorite game to introduce to new players or play with those who know it. All games checked into the game vault will be accessible to those in the open gaming area.

### COSPLAY CONTEST:

Costumes will be judged on creativity, conformity to lore, story, hero, etc. You may NOT use any true weapons. Anything that looks like a weapon must be created from non-harmful materials. Be considerate of the PG-13 nature of the event, costumes that are not PG-13 will not be allowed to compete. Otherwise, anything goes.

### TOURNAMENTS:

Competition at beginner level and more advanced levels. Magic: The Gathering, chess, checkers, Pokémon TCG and some on the fly tournaments for popular fast games. Let us know when you register if you are signing up for tournaments.

### TRADE ZONE:

Where two or more scouts are gathered together, trading will happen! So there will be a zone set up for all to use. Please keep trading out of the game play zones.

## What to Bring:

## Fees:

\$30 per participant for tent camping.

\$35 per participant for a bed in the Pueblo

(bring sheets or a sleeping bag)

\$25 for Mission Support—20 slots available (First Class and Adults ages 16 and older).

All fees are due by March 8th. After March 8th registration fees increase by \$5.

# RULES...

## Trading:

- No monetary trades.
- Trades between adults and youth is strictly prohibited.
- Disputes between traders are void.
- Tabletop gaming, comics and scouting related items only.
- No weapons, electronics, or especially valuable items are permitted in trade.

## Tournaments:

- Tournaments will be designated as youth only or adult only as necessary.
- Players will be designated with a 1-5 rank, 5 being expert. Players will profess their skill level, tournaments will be based on skill level.

## Cosplay Contest:

No actual weapons. Weapons for cosplay must be clearly manufactured costume work. Costumes must be PG-13 and represent game/story/movie lore. Youth only and adult only competition.

## Game Vault:

Do not put anything in the game vault for others to play that is considered collectable, rare, or valuable. By putting a game in the vault, you are loaning it to fellow scouts. Treat his/her property like it is your own. We want hundreds of choices!

**Check the value of items you wish to trade beforehand!**
