Earth Sciences Introduction & Objectives

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Core Competencies: Students will go through experiential learning by reviewing literature and actively participating in classroom discussions and debates on concepts related to various environment related topics within the theme of **“Anthropogenic Global Changes: Through the Lens of Pessimists and Optimists.”** Students are expected to analyze peer-reviewed scientific articles, form coherent discussion points, and propose evidence-based solutions and outlooks drawn from one week-long discussions. At the end of the program, students will write a brief review article/essay (2-3 pages) and deliver a final oral presentation on various chosen themes.
