### Format and Scoring

- 3-person scramble
- Maximum handicap for men = 30, Maximum handicap for women = 36
- Maximum net score per hole is double bogey
- Minimum 3 drives per player.
- Once on green, 2 putt maximum

### Par 3 Contests

- On/Off Green Contests: Eligible par 3 holes will not have a flag, as there will be 3 unmarked holes. Players can play any hole of their choice.
- Hole-in-One Contest: Eligible par 3 holes will be marked with a flag with the prize to be awarded to the first Hole-in-One.
