

2020 Conclave Packing List

Being prepared for the environment is one of the most important factors to having an enjoyable weekend. Here is a list of the mandatory items you will need to bring and also some optional items to consider. Try not to overburden yourselves with unnecessary gear by packing only the essentials. All of your items should fit into a single backpack or be worn on your body.

Weather on Oahu in April is typically mild and warm with temperature ranging from the high 70s (°F) to mid 80s. At Camp Pupukea, the evenings can get into the mid 60s. Rainfall in April tends to be less than the winter months, but windward showers can happen at anytime. Participants will be sleeping in wall tents on cots, so sleeping bags are suggested. Please plan accordingly.

Mandatory Items: (make sure your name is labeled on everything)

1. ID/Passport
2. Full Scout Field Uniform (hat, shirt, neckerchief, belt, pants, socks and OA Sash)
3. Rain gear
4. First-aid kit
5. Extra Clothing (undergarments, socks, shirts, etc. also for activities)
6. Jacket
7. Sleeping Bag and/or bedding
8. Water bottle/Canteen
9. Mess Kit
10. Flashlight/Headlamp (with extra batteries)
11. Sunscreen and bug spray
12. Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, razor, etc.)
13. Towel and washcloth
14. Notebook and pen/pencil
15. Money (to spend at the Trading Post and Silent Patch Auction)

Optional Items:

1. Swimsuit
2. Watch
3. Camera (cell phone)
4. Small and Large heavy-duty trash bags
5. Shower Slippers / Flip-Flops
Note: Other than in the shower, there should be no open-toed shoes at camp
6. Extra Ziploc Bags
7. Pillow
8. Laundry bag
9. Pocketknife (must be stowed in checked bags when traveling)
