	Program Notes
Schedule/Live Meetings:	Each Merit Badge will be a combination of live facilitated meetings <u>AND</u> work that will need to be completed independently. A Scout will need to attend <u>all</u> scheduled live meetings (for the live meeting time option you select) in order to complete all of the requirements covered. Live meetings occur on every day listed for each time option. For example, if you take First Aid Merit Badge and you select the 2:00pm option, you will have live meetings on Tuesday from 2:00pm - 3:00pm and Thursday from 2:00pm - 3:00pm; you must attend both. As another example, if you take Nature Merit Badge, and you select the 11am session, you must attend on Monday from 11:00am - 12:00pm and Wednesday from 11:00am - 12:00pm; you must attend both. In addition, for both examples there is additional work that will need to be completed outside of those scheduled live sessions.
Merit Badge Registration Limit:	Your Scout can take up to four merit badges per week. In addition to their merit badges, they may sign-up for Rank Advancement, and the Firecrafter Ranks of Camper and Woodsman (these do not count towards the four total). They also have access to the various camp experiences (i.e. campfire, camp tours, fun activities). When planning your Scout's schedule keep in mind the estimated daily time commitment and your family schedule.
Pre-Requisite OR Post- Requisite Requirements:	These are requirements that will not be completed during the weekly experience. Your Scout will need to complete these requirements with their Troop or Merit Badge Counselor in-person before or after the experience. These can be submitted during the week of your experience. You can find these requirements in the BSA Merit Badge Pamphlet for each specific merit badge at this website: www.scouting.org/programs/scouts-bsa/advancement-and-awards/merit-badges/
Daily Time Commitment:	This is the estimated amount of time that your Scout will be spending on that particular merit badge each day in order to complete the requirements. This includes the time in the live sessions and independently outside of the live session. Please remember that offering these merit badges in this format has not been done before, so these are estimates. Although you can sign-up for up to 4 merit badges per week, it is recommended that for younger Scouts you sign-up for fewer than 4 merit badges due to the time commitment required. Scouts will have until the Wednesday following your Summer Experience week to submit requirements to the Google Classroom.
Firecrafter - Camper and Woodsman Ranks:	These ranks are completed through the Firecrafter Organization and administered by the Summer Experience. All requirements will need to be completed during your week in order to earn the rank. The live meeting sessions will be conducted via an open format, and you are encouraged to join during the first live session. Consult with your Scoutmaster before participating in these ranks. Signup is required for the Firecrafter ranks of Camper and Woodsman.
Rank Advancement:	Rank Advancement (defined as rank requirements found in the Tenderfoot, 2nd Class, and 1st Class ranks) will be administered by two methods. The first method is guided instructional videos and activities. Your Scout will have access to these when the sign-up for a particular rank. For example, if your Scout needs to complete Tenderfoot Requirement 3a they will have access to instructional videos. The second method is instruction via Live Meetings. These Live Meeting Sessions will be open format and any requirement (that can be completed virtually) can be covered. Your Scout will have access to both live meeting sessions to get additional help or work on additional requirements. They can attend one, both, or neither depending upon their needs. These open live meeting sessions will be similar to the "office hours" concept. Each Rank Advancement program will cover only carefully selected requirements. Finally, the counselor will be teaching the skill to your Scout; each Troop has various requirements in order to officially sign-off the skill in your Scout's Handbook. Sign-up is required for Rank Advancement, but does not count towards the four merit badge maximum.
Daily Camp Experiences / "Command Post":	Each Session, your Scout will have access to fun adventures, videos, and activities that help bring the spirit of camp to you. Some examples include a live campfire program, tours of camp, competitions, STEM experiments, and other fun activities. There is no sign up required for these activities. Your Scout will have access through the Summer Experience Command Post Google Classroom platform to enjoy, according to their schedule. The access code for this Google Classroom will be sent via email to you.
