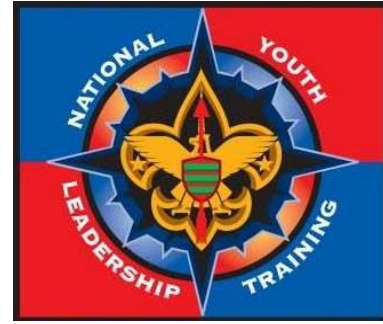


NYLT

NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING



Built on the legacy of past JLT successes, NYLT integrates the best of modern leadership theory with the traditional strengths of the Scouting experience. Through activities, presentations, challenges, discussions, and audio-visual support, NYLT participants will be engaged in a unified approach to leadership that will give them the skills and confidence to lead well. Through a wide range of activities, events, games, and adventures, NYLT participants will work and play together as they put into action the best that Scouting has to offer.

NYLT models a month in the life of a Troop— three meetings (one each day for the first three days) leading up to a big outdoor experience (an overnight outpost camp). The course uses the team method and presents model Team Leaders' Council meetings. Teams are challenged early in the course to present to the group at the end of the week their "Quest for the Meaning of Leadership." While the challenge is designed to have teams experience the four stages of team development, it will help teams and individual Scouts internalize the leadership skills and concepts being presented to them along the way. Throughout the course, the staff will be modeling the concepts and skills that are the core content of the course. The teams will be challenged with many activities and games, including using GPS receivers to participate in a *Geocache* game. The focus of each session is not only knowledge but giving the youth a "Toolbox of Skills" that equips them with the "how" of leadership.

NYLT is a 6-day training course that provides youth leaders with an opportunity to enhance their leadership skills while living by the Scout Oath, Scout Law and Venturing Oath in an exciting outdoor environment. Scouts who complete the NYLT course are prepared to meet the challenges ahead and are better prepared to work with adult leaders.

To be eligible to attend, a Scout must meet the following requirements:

- Be **currently registered** as a member of the Boy Scouts of America.
- Have attended a **week long camp**.
- Be **FIRST CLASS** rank or higher or a Venture Scout.
- Be the **minimum age of 13 years old** before the first day of the course.
- Be a **current or prospective youth leader recommended** by his/her Scoutmaster or Advisor.
- Be able to **attend the entire course and orientation meeting**.

This course will be limited to 42 participants on a first come first serve basis. **Out of Council Applicants** may send in an application and \$110 deposit (which will be refunded if not selected). These applicants will be placed on a waiting list. After March 5th, 2019, any remaining openings within the course will be made available to these applicants on a first come first serve basis.

COURSE INFORMATION

WHEN: Orientation Meeting with participant and parent or Scoutmaster: Sunday, March 24, 2019. Orientation time and location to be determined.

Note: Orientation Meeting is mandatory for the participant and a parent and the Scoutmaster.

First Weekend of the Course: Friday, March 29, 2019. First session begins at 6:00 p.m., concluding at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, March 31, 2019.

Second Weekend of the Course: Friday, April 12, 2019. First session begins at 6:00 p.m., concluding by 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 14, 2019.
