This packet is intended for you to pass along to your unit. It contains all of the information that is necessary for your unit participants to come to the event prepared to have a good time. It is very important that this packet be read & understood. As scouts, please BE PREPARED!

This year's theme for Spring Fling is Snoopy and the Beagle Scouts. Scouts will participate in various snoopy and camping themed activities.

As with all Three Rivers events, the scout oath, law, motto, slogan & the outdoor code will be followed & enforced during the weekend.

Registration

Registrations should be done online as a unit by one adult who will be the contact person. No one should register individually. The first adult on the registration site should be the unit's contact person. **THIS PERSON IS RESPONSIBLE FOR COMMUNICATING ALL OF THE EVENT INFORMATION TO THE UNIT'S PARTICIPANTS.** Information packets will be sent out to the contact person within three days of the online registration closing. The link to the online registration can be found on the calendar of the district website, <http://threerivers.nbsa.org>. Online registration will close at 11:45 pm on April 3rd. Refunds are not given to participants that cancel within one week of the event. Food and program materials have already been purchased.

Registration Prices:

Now until April 3rd: Youth \$26.00; Adult \$15.00

Staff registrations must be done online. They do not have a registration fee.

Early registrations are very much appreciated so that supplies & food can be planned accordingly. After April 3rd, registrations will be taken by emailing Heather Klemm at dancemom79@outlook.com. Prices will then be: youth \$31.00; adult - \$20.00. A confirmation email will be sent out to ensure that your unit is registered & will be needed at check in. No registrations will be taken after 10:00pm April 5th.

Registered Cub Scouts and Girl Scouts ages Kindergarten through Fifth grade are allowed to attend Spring Fling. Parent to scout ratios must be followed. These ratios can be found on the ThreeRivers District website.

A day or two before the event, the contact adult for the unit will receive an email with the parking pass, the unit roster to fill in and any other information they will need when they arrive at camp. It is strongly recommended that the contact adult forward the email to all of its participants so that everyone's questions are answered.

For any district event, the event will be at risk of being canceled if there are less than 50 participants registered when the online registration link closes.

Check In

Check in will begin at 7:45 am at Weaver Lodge. The adult registered as the contact person should be the adult to check in the entire unit. Please come prepared with a roster of participants, health forms, shooting sports permission forms, waiver forms for any girlscouts and payment for anyone that did not pay online. The necessary forms needed for this event can be found on the main page of the registration site.

Anyone that does not turn in a shooting sports permission form will not be allowed to participate in the shooting sports activity. **Girl Scout participants will need to sign a waiver form.** Checks should be made out to NSC cost center 278. It is expected that all units are checked in & that all participants be at Weaver Lodge ready to begin by 8:15am. You will receive a detailed schedule of activities and map at check in along with the evaluation forms that will need to be turned in at check out. Opening ceremony will begin promptly at 8:30 am.

Parking

Vehicles need to be parked in designated parking lots with a parking pass clearly displayed on the windshield. Parking on the side of the road is not allowed. Participants need to walk between activities & will not be allowed to shuttle between activities. Due to the large number of participants at camp, carpooling is strongly recommended.

Essential Equipment

Each participant should have with them for the day: a daypack, **a reusable cup**, & a water bottle. A snack is recommended to have with also. Remember, this is an outdoor event, it is very important to **DRESS FOR THE WEATHER!** Boots, snow pants, mittens, & hats may be needed, or a poncho & rain boots could be required.

Activities Planned

The activities planned for Spring Fling this year are: Snoopy's Dog House, The Flying Red Baron, BB Guns, Snoopy's Dog Food, Crossing the River Relay, and In the Wilderness with the Beagle Scouts. These activities will begin promptly at 9am for the first rotation & will run for 65 minute sessions, with the last rotation ending at 3:40 pm. Closing Flag ceremony will take place at 4:00pm with checkout immediately following. There will be 2 lunch rotations. A detailed schedule & rotation map will be given out to participants at check in.

Menu

The lunch menu will be burgers, tator tots and veggies. Peanut butter & jelly sandwiches are available as an alternative by asking at the kitchen door. If anyone in your unit has any dietary restrictions, please contact Heather Klemm (dancemom79@outlook.com) at least one week prior to the event so that we can do our best to accommodate those needs. **Cups are not provided during meals. You must bring your own.** A trading post will be available to purchase snack foods at Weaver Lodge anytime during the day on Saturday. There is also a trading post at the Campmaster building as you enter the camp.

First Aid

In the event that someone from your unit is injured & first aid is needed beyond your unit's abilities, a first responder is on staff at the Three Rivers Cub Scout events.

Expectations

As with all Three Rivers District events, it is expected that all scouts will act in a scout-like manner. Not being respectful to other scouts, adults or the event staff will result in that scout and adult participant being asked to leave the event. It is also expected that adults will help enforce this behavior during the event. It is also an expectation at all Three Rivers District Cub Scout events, there will be no smoking in camp. Smoking is never to be seen by any scouts.

Check Out

For checkout, your unit's contact person should checkout your unit at Weaver Lodge. Evaluation forms will need to be turned in to receive your requirements completed form & your patches.
