

# Northern Tier During MEA Weekend!

October 17-20, 2019

Join us for this *mini adventure* during *MEA Weekend* at the Northern Tier High Adventure Base. For only \$150 per person plus transportation we will have a mini wilderness adventure on the Boundary Waters Canoe Area!

We will leave Mankato on October 17th (transportation arrangements, including methods of transportation and times, will be determined once we know who is interested in attending) and arrive at basecamp in time for dinner. We will sleep in cabins that evening. After breakfast on the 18th, we will hit the water and continue our adventure until arriving back at base camp on October 20th to check in our gear, have lunch, then depart for home.

Trip will include food starting with dinner on the 17th through lunch on the 20th, canoe, safety gear, crew equipment, and staff guide. Each participant will be responsible for personal gear.

Since this is a mini adventure, Scouts BSA, Venturers, and adult leaders of all ages can participate as long as they are classified as "swimmers" and have a Class A, B, and C physical form. Participants must also be between 100 and 295 pounds.

## Personal Gear Needed

**Required Gear:** Pair of boots (full ankle support, rugged sole, not water proof OR hip boots/muck style boots that come up to past the calf), camp shoes, rain gear, pants, shirts, socks (synthetic or wool, no cotton), underwear (quick dry), hat, jacket, clean/dry clothes, sleeping bag, waterproof sack, sleeping pad, camp towel, personal toiletries, mess kit, water bottle, headlamp, whistle, lip balm, sunglasses, personal medications, small pocket knife, small compass.

**Optional Gear:** Camera, fishing equipment, long underwear, book, journal.

**What NOT to bring:** Canoe chairs that clip or strap to canoes, electronic music, game, or video devices.
