SCOUT RELEASE REQUEST

Scouts desiring to leave Camp Mountain Run with an individual who is not the Scout's legal parent or guardian, prior to his unit's departure, must have a release signed by his parents or guardian and approved by the unit leader. Scouts will normally be permitted to leave only when accompanied by their parents. This form must be used in handling other departures.

In an emergency, it may not be possible for a parent or a guardian to sign a release. In this event, sufficient information must be recorded attesting to the telephone call or means of communication by which word arrived asking for the release of the Scout. This information should document the person from whom the call was received, verify telephone confirmation of the parent asking for the Scout and give detailed reasons for the requested release.
