ADULT VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION:

- 1) Be responsible and follow the directions of the Camp Director and the Camp Rules.
- 2) Attend planning and training meetings when requested prior to Camp to ensure familiarization with the activities, standards, and emergency plans.
- 3) Develop and use small activities, songs, stories, etc., to keep Scouts occupied during waiting periods. Try to make them specific to the Camp's Theme or Cub Scouting.
- 4) Be at check-in no later than 20 minutes (2:40pm) before start of camp to ensure that all needed materials are present and to greet the Scouts as they arrive.
- 5) Assist in maintaining a clean Camp area by picking up litter and putting away activity materials when requested.
- 6) Maintain 2-deep leadership at all times.
- 7) Keep the Scouts in your activity area until the end of their activity period. Do not permit them to wander off in the middle of the session.
- 8) For Walking Den Leaders, provide a daily detailed attendance record to the Camp Headquarters as soon as the opening ceremony is complete and the Dens are dismissed for the first activity period.
- 9) For Walking Den Leaders, at the end of each day, remain in the camp area until all the boys in your den have been picked up by their parents or guardians. Ensure they are signed out.
- 10) For Station Staff, develop an interesting and entertaining way to present your activity. If in need of assistance, contact the Program Director.
- 11) For Range Officers, attend the BSA-required training course for the specific shooting sport activity. Encourage sharing, fair play, sportsmanship, and politeness among both Scouts and Staff.
- 12) Maintain good communication with the Camp Director and Program Director. Report any problems or suggestions as you encounter them.
- 13) Always maintain a professional demeanor with all Scouts and parents
